In this chapter I will discuss the development of social cognitive career theory (Lent et al 1994), an application of Bandura's (1977, 1982, 1986) social cognitive theory to vocational work Lent and colleagues set out to use SCT to predict and link interest development, choice of academic and career options, and performance and persistence in
