Check your blood sugar right away if you have any symptoms of low blood sugar If you think your blood sugar is low but cannot check it at that time, treat anyway Treat by eating or drinking 15 grams of something high in sugar, such as: Wait 15 minutes and then check your blood sugar again:

What Role Does Sugar Play in the Body?

blood sugar levels High-GI foods are digested rapidly and raise blood sugar levels quickly whereas low-GI foods are more slowly digested and produce a gradual raise in glucose and insulin levels in the blood Products with sugar, corn syrup, molasses, and hidden sugars (ingredients ending in -ose) usually indicate a high-GI food

Hyperglycemia: High Blood Sugar

Glucose (sugar) in your blood is used for energy for all parts of your body When the amount of glucose is too high, you have a high blood sugar, or hyperglycemia If your blood is high in sugar it can become thick and sticky, like other liquids that are high in sugar (syrup or ...

your blood sugar is below 50 take 30 grams of carbohydrate Wait 15 minutes then recheck your blood sugar If it is still below 70, take another 15 grams of carbohydrate Wait another 15 minutes then recheck your blood sugar again Once your blood sugar is above 70, be sure to eat a meal or snack within an hour to keep from dropping again

Hyperglycemia - High Blood Sugar * Hyperglycemia occurs when the blood sugar level becomes too high High Blood Sugar = Blood Sugar (greater than) > 200 mg/dl * High blood sugar can be caused by: not enough insulin, too much food, illness, inactivity or stress * High blood sugar generally develops over a longer period of time

If your blood sugar level is in the "high normal" range, you are still at risk for type 2 diabetes In one study, researchers tracked the blood sugar levels of 46,000 people for seven years People with a blood sugar level between 95-99 were 233 times more likely to develop diabetes than people with normal blood sugar levels
